Cheryl gave some history background on Maude Moore Latham and her daughter May Gordon Latham Kellenberger who donated more than \$3 million dollars to rebuild the Palace.

To date they have raised approximately \$58.2 million and they still need to raise approximately \$2.4 million for completion of the project.
